### INTRODUCTION TO READINGS: TWENTY-SECOND SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

**First Reading:** Sirach 3:17-18, 20, 28-29: The book of Sirach was written by a wise teacher who lived 2000 years before Christ. Sirach ran a school for young people in Jerusalem. In today's section, he gives his students a string of wise sayings to guide them in their conduct.

**Second Reading:** Hebrews 12:18-19, 22-24 - In today's reading from the letter to the Hebrews, the author contrasts two covenants. He begins with the covenant established by Jesus at Mount Zion (which is another name for Jerusalem).

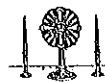


